A trip to Morwellham Quay on 28th February will enable us to step into the Victorian era and make comparisons with the Tudors and see how life has changed. The Industrial Revolution will cause steam to come out of our ears whilst Hans Holbein and Lowry will get our creative juices flowing.

Geography: Since this was an era the world was being explored, we will examine the difference between Tudor and Victorian maps and their views of the world.

D.T: We will spend time learning about the delicacies enjoyed in Tudor and Victorian England and will sample some of these. Whilst we are learning about Victorian children we will make zoetropes.

Art: Hans Holbein will be the first artist; we will be looking at his Tudor portraits. The Victorian artist will be Lowry and his interpretation of the Industrial era.
