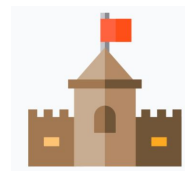
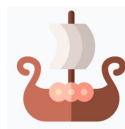
Year 1 have been engrossed in their DT this week - soup making! A massive thank you once again to Tesco's for providing us with all the healthy food to make this possible!
