Maths:

For the first part of this half term the children will be continuing with their learning on **Number:** unit and non unit fractions:

The children will cover the following:

- Adding fractions
- · Subtracting fractions
- Partitioning the whole
- · Unit fractions of a set of objects
- Non unit fractions of a set of objects

We will then move on to Measurement: Mass and capacity

English:

This half term our learning has a Science and Geography focus which links to our English. We will begin with writing to inform using the focus of a factual report showcasing all they have learned about rocks. In order to do this we will be learning to construct simple, compound and complex sentences into coherent paragraphs using a range of expanded noun phrases. Next, we continue writing to inform incorporating imagination in our writing with a diary recount of a trip up a mountain. This will be using pronouns, prepositions, adverbs in the past tense. We conclude our English for the term with writing to entertain with a setting description. Recapping on previous learning of expanded noun phrases, senses and tenses will ensure we have some amazing creative writing.

Reading

It is really important that your child continues to read at home. Please ensure you continue to log this on *BOOMreader*. As well as developing reading fluency, it is important that you ask your child **VIPERS** style questions to help their reading comprehension. What has happened? What do you think will happen? Why does this character behave like this? are just some examples of questions that can be asked.

Spelling

We are continuing to look at phonics for our spelling learning. Your child will be set weekly spellings. A spelling sheet will be sent home and each week these spellings will be on Spelling Shed.
