# **DRAWING: Applying Tone**

Sketching graphite pencils come in a range of grades, from 9B to 9H, that describe the tone of the line that each pencil will produce.


The H stands for hard and the B for black.

The harder pencil leaves less graphite on the surface, resulting in lighter mark-making.

Vocabulary: tone, pencil grades, graphite, contemporary, sketch



If you change the pressure that you apply to your pencil, you will change the tone too!



## **PRINTING: String Printing**

String printing involves arranging string into a pattern or shape, which you then glue to a hard material (e.g. cardboard) and print from (using ink).

Children should experiment with different colours and printing onto different materials.



Vocabulary: string printing, geometric, cubism, minimalistic




# PAINTING: Tints and Colour Spectrums

Value refers to the lightness or darkness of a color. A light color is a tint. For example, pink is a tint of red. A dark color is called a shade.

There are six tertiary Colors: Red-Orange, Yellow-Orange, Yellow-Green, Blue-Green, Blue-Violet, Red-Violet, which are formed by mixing a primary colour with a secondary colour.

- White = tint.
- Black = shade.

Vocabulary: tint, shade, tertiary colours, bold, spectrum



## TEXTILES & COLLAGE: Layering, Pattern and Texture

Collage is a piece of art created by combining photos, clippings, materials or small objects onto backing material, such as a piece of paper.

You can add depth to your collage by layering different colours or materials on top of eachother.

A pattern is a design in which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated.

Texture is the physical feel of something, e.g. smooth, rough, fuzzy or slimy.



<u>Vocabulary:</u> layering, texture, clippings, depth, flotsam weaving



#### 3D FORM: Simple Joins

Join means to connect a line, or place or things.

Malleable play helps children to develop their fine motor skills. It uses malleable materials, which are materials that you can easily manipulate, such as Play-Doh or clay.

If a material is malleable, it can be easily transformed with hands or tools.

Vocabulary: malleable materials, air-dry, joins, texture





You can join different materials by moulding, twisting, gluing or folding!
