Grammar in all writing:

- Use a variety of sentence types in all of our writing
 - Simple, compound and complex (with a variety of adverbial clauses starting with subordinate conjunctions).
- Use expanded noun phrases to describe DAN (determiner, adjective, noun)
- Use the present and past tenses correctly in all our writing with a focus on present perfect instead of simple past tense e.g. present perfect - I have walked, past tense - I walked
- Express time, place, cause and enhance cohesion using adverbs (soon, therefore, finally) and prepositions, including prepositional phrases (during the night, before breakfast, because of the rain).
- Use pronouns to avoid repetition.

- Use commas to separate clauses in complex sentences.
- Start to use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech.

- Use 'show not tell' to convey character emotions.
