

Online Safety (PSHE)

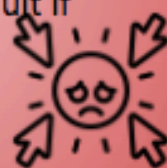
Respectful behaviour



- Permission is needed before using copyrighted material
- Permission is needed before posting any information about other people online
- 'Fair Use' is the idea that you can reuse something that another person has created, in certain amounts and for certain purposes, without breaking the law.

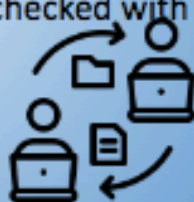
Online bullying (intentional unkindness Several time on Purpose)

- Leave only positive comments online
- Real people with feelings are behind the posts which are written
- Talk to a friend or trusted adult if upset by anything online



Sharing Information

- Permission is needed before posting any information about other people online
- Never share age, address, name, school, clubs
- Privacy settings must be checked with a trusted adult

- Use Numbers, Uppercase/Lowercase & Symbols (NULS)
- Use a website to check how secure my password is (www.security.org/how-secure-is-my-password/)
- A trusted adult will help you choose a password
